At 12 weeks old I caught my first ball. At 7 months old I went swimming for the first time. On February 17, 2003, I celebrated my first birthday. One month later I had my first grand mal seizure.

Back then we were busy raising awareness. Today we are busy raising funds and helping to collect blood samples for the research. Back then there were fewer than 100 blood samples and no epilepsy grant to study Aussies. Today there are over 1000 samples and an epilepsy grant for the Australian Shepherd with three researchers working together on this disease.
